ATTENDANCE

If your child is going to be absent or tardy, please call the attendance line at (860)709-6800 and leave a message with your child’s name, teacher and reason for absence. A message can be left twenty-four hours a day. If your child is seen by their doctor, please send in a doctor’s note.

Parents are required to submit **written documentation** for an absence to be excused. This means that a phone call without timely, written follow-up will automatically be coded as unexcused.

The following Immunizations are required for Kindergarten:

- DTAP (Must be received on or after the age 4).
- MMR -2nd dose
- IPV/Polio (Must be received on or after the age of 4).
- Varicella -2nd dose

An updated physical that has occurred AFTER August 31, 2016 **MUST** be obtained prior to the start of kindergarten.

To avoid any last minute scrambling, please make any necessary appointments with your child's doctor prior to the start of school this Fall, and get all paperwork to me as soon as you can. This will ensure a seamless transition to Kindergarten.
